3. MATTERS ARISING

- a] Mrs.Regan confirmed the name of the person who raised the Lake Lane proposed development and badgers sets at the last meeting was Mrs.Jones.
- b] Mrs.Regan confirmed that Frys' are no longer parking their vehicles in the entrance to the John Holt play area in Quarry Lane.
- C] The Clerk reported that he had been able to arrange the site meeting concerning the possible use of land owned by Bridport Town Council next to the Lower Walditch Development for the 16 March 2000 at 10.00am.

4. REPORT BY CTY & DIST COUNCILLOR REAR ADMIRAL PRITCHARD CB

Rear Admiral Pritchard presented to the Parish Council on behalf of WDDC 2 Millennium plaques. He confirmed that any additional tipping away costs for transporting the waste away from Bridport once the tip has closed is the responsibility of DCC.

8. REQUEST FOR GRANTS

Request for grant towards the cost of celebrating the closure of the Tip. Mr.Matthews declared an interest and took no part in this matter. The Clerk reported that he had contacted the DATPC, Parish Council can make a grant or donation if in the opinion of the Parish Council it is in the interests of the parish or any part of it, or is in the interests of all or some of its inhabitants. It was suggest that if a grant was given it should be towards the costs of the hire of marquee and not towards food or drink. Mrs. Ball proposed a grant of £400; this was seconded by Mrs.Regan. Mrs.England put forward a second proposal of £250, which was seconded by Mr.Yates. Professor Eastham was in the Chair for this item and asked for a vote for the second proposal, which resulted in 2 votes for and 3 votes against. Professor Eatham then asked for vote on the first proposal, which resulted in 2 votes for and 3 votes against.
