RE: A35/SEA ROAD SOUTH, BRIDPORT, DORSET DT6

The Parish Council wrote to you in July 2019 regarding the speed limit along the A35/Sea Road South and the light controlled pedestrian crossing at the end of Sea Road South.

We have now had other complaints from residents, the most recent from a resident of Bothenhampton who has asked for a second light controlled pedestrian crossing half way along on Sea Road South so that pedestrians can cross safely.

When we wrote in July 2019 you advised that a route safety study of the A35 was being commenced with a conclusion date mid-2020.

We realise that the study may have been delayed due to the Covid-19 outbreak but we were wondering when this will be concluded and what improvements are being considered, and crucially whether or not a second pedestrian crossing is likely to be installed along this road.

We would be very grateful for a response as soon as practicable in order for us to re-assure our residents that this matter is being progressed.
