2	<p>MAIN BUSINESS (Cont.)</p> <p>Spinners Lane Clerk contacted Cllr JB on the 21st October and Cllr JB confirmed that there had been no response from his contact in Spinners Lane.</p> <p>Feedback from the Chair on the work of the VFO Councillors recognise that the VFO has worked very hard over the summer months cutting back invasive weeds and keeping pathways and tracks cleared. Looking into the coming Autumn months there is still much work to be done especially along Tony's Track and other routes around the two villages. There was agreement that the Parish Council should show its usual appreciation to the VFO for the hard work undertaken during the year.</p> <p>Traffic Speed – signs and self-funding DC initiative Councillors have noted that 3 of the 20mph signs have been removed (and taken away) Cllr CA confirmed that he does have some spare signs and it was agreed that these should be concreted in. Cllrs CA, GS and MW to concrete replacement posts into place.</p> <p>Cllr CA referred to the response from Dorset Council's Lindsey Watson to his submission to the Place and Resources Overview Committee, he said he was not impressed with Ms Watson's response. There had been discussion at the Main Committee Meeting on the 10th October with Dorset Councillor Clayton on the possibility of the Parish Council self-funding the 20mph limit initiative itself and it was agreed at that meeting to raise this at the next T T & F meeting.</p> <p>This matter was duly discussed, and it was agreed that the Clerk will write to Mr Tony Burden Road Safety Manager (Highways) at Dorset Council and ask whether a self-funding initiative would be possible and if so the process and procedure to follow.</p> <p>Lengthsman's Hours (to 25th August 2022) The latest iteration of the Lengthsman's hours received from Bridport Town Council was reviewed by T T & F councillors and noted.</p> <p>Reference was made to Cllr GS's email detailing the work that needed to be done by the Lengthsman which referred to repairs to benches located in Bothenhampton by the Church. This matter had already been discussed at the Finance and Funding sub-committee and it was determined that these benches are not owned by the parish council and should therefore not be repaired at its expense.
