## **RE: ADDITIONAL DOG BINS**

Thank you for your prompt about the dog bins. Since our letter to you of 18<sup>th</sup> February, and our Clerk's email of 11<sup>th</sup> March regarding councillors' request for a delay, the issue has yet to be resolved, unfortunately.

We have asked our new Footpaths Officer to identify where existing bins are, and where any new bins might be best placed. Our Finance Sub-committee will then look at the cost and recommend whether we can afford any of the bins residents have asked us to install.

The Management Plan group for Bothenhampton Nature Reserve may well consider provision of dog bins there, to match the provision already in place at Jellyfields.

However, we would like to proceed with the litter bin we requested for Lower Walditch Play Area, as identified on the plan we sent you. Anne Loades can provide more information about the precise location.
