	Volunteer Footpaths Officer	
	Cllr MW provided an overview of the progress so far by the VFO in particular that he has:	
	 Completed the on-line first aid course (note – this will need to be supplemented by the 'Red Cross' Course in February 2022). TC to place on the Finance Sub-Committee Agenda to get the payment agreed. 	
	 Obtained the first aid kit via ebay (and has been refunded via TC) Completed an inventory of his tool kit. 	
	 Has walked the footpaths around the Bothenhampton side of Bothen Hill and has not been able to walk the footpaths further afield because of the virus. 	
	 Raised the issue of Way Markers and should he start using them. There was agreement that he should start way marking if possible. He confirmed he was not running out of way markers and would use the ones that he has in storage. Raised the issue of Marbone Lane that runs down to the nature 	
	reserve and that there is a planning notice about resurfacing. There was discussion about which authority has placed the resurfacing notice. Cllr MW to go back to VFO and to ask him to take a picture of the planning notice and send to the Clerk. Cllr JB said that the footpath number is W5/13.	
	 Cllr MW said that he will go out with VFO at some point when the virus is over. 	
	Cllr JB said that the parish council will need to note and register all their footpaths with Dorset Council (BLAP meeting). TC asked whether the state of the footpath also needed to be noted and whether all footpaths irrespective of whether it has a number or name. Cllr JB said that this is the case. Discussed the difficulties with this as some of the footpaths adjoin neighbouring parishes (eg: Shipton Gorge or Bradpole). Discussion about the various footpaths and tracks that are impassable. Cllr JB mentioned the Senior Ranger at Dorset Council Russell Goff. Cllr JB said the list should be completed by next year.	
	Cllr CA asked Cllr JB whether there were any formal instructions as to what the parish council must produce, so that it is clear and that the information, when gathered will be useful and acted upon.	

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	TC said that both Cllrs AL and CS attend BLAP. TC to contact Cllr AL to ascertain the facts from her around this.	TC
	Cllr MW asked Cllr JB who the Footpaths Officer working in Shipton Gorge was and Cllr JB said he would email it.	Cllr JB
	30mph Speed Limit, Walditch Road	
	With reference to the email from Mr M Farnham of Dorset Council advising that the work will not be started on this project until Summer (due to the virus).	
	Email from Michael Potter regarding Crock Lane	
	The email confirmed that Crock Lane cannot have 20mph signs and must remain 30mph. Cllr JB said that there should be 30mph at both ends of Crock Lane and a warning about pedestrians in the road. TC said that she would draft an email and send to councillors for review, and then send to Michael Potter.	TC
	Any Other Business Cllr MW referred to his conversation with one local resident (Ray J) and the SSE contractors regarding the state of the A35 Trunk Road and the traffic signs that have not yet been removed. Cllr MW to follow up when the virus lockdown is eased.	Cllr MW
	The meeting ended at 4.10pm and the Clerk reminded councillors of the date of next meeting – 3 rd July 2020 at 3.30pm.
