## RE: JELLYFIELDS NATURE RESERVE AND BOTHENHAMPTON NATURE RESERVE (QUARRY LANE / WANDEWELL)

I refer to our letters of the 15<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> January and to your subsequent email of 22<sup>nd</sup> January.

We have had an Extraordinary General Meeting and have agreed that the parish council would be delighted to work with you on the 10-year management plan to make both reserves family friendly and great places to be.

We have agreed to contribute an initial £500 towards the creation of the ten-year management plan and on setup a further £500 in the following year. The parish council will commit to pay a similar amount over the period of the partnership.

We understand that a parish councillor will be a member of the management plan committee from the earliest stages, both in drafting the plan and in implementing it, so as to reflect the views of the parish. Please let us know when the first meeting will take place.

We assume that there will be a formal partnership agreement drawn up setting out the various expectations of each party and we would welcome input into this.

Please also let us know when and to what account the funds need to be transferred.
